Sealed bids are hereby solicited for construction of an Apron Expansion project at the Virginia Tech Montgomery Executive Airport. Improvements include demolition & removal, excavation and embankment construction, constructing new airfield pavement, new electrical items, erosion and sediment control, stormwater piping, and other ancillary work associated with the improvements.

This is a unit price Contract. Bids will be received in the office of the Airport Manager, 1601 Research Center Dr., Blacksburg, VA 24060 until 11:00 a.m., prevailing local time, May 9, 2024. Bids received after that time will not be accepted. Bids will be open publicly and read aloud immediately following receipt of the bids.

The procedure specified under Section 2.2-4330(A) (i), VA Code Ann. shall apply: “...the bidder shall give notice in writing of his claim of right to withdraw his bid within two (2) business days after the conclusion of the bid opening procedure”.
